**Description:** There are many factors that can make outdoor site lighting confusing, especially when trying to be environmentally responsible. Some of the issues that a specifier may face are state and local codes, lighting quality, lighting efficacy and protecting the environment. This program discusses how lighting impacts the environment and ways to lessen that impact through the use of efficient luminaires, lighting based on the zone the project is located in, legislative requirements and how utilizing these ideas will help a project earn LEED credits.

**Learning Objectives:** Professionals will analyze environmentally sound ways to use lighting to reduce overall energy consumption and promote environmental responsibility; learn ways to effectively illuminate an outdoor environment while preventing glare and light pollution; learn about environmentally sound ways to provide security lighting for an outdoor environment; and learn ways to use light that is suitable for the particular project, while maintaining an aesthetically pleasing and eco-friendly environment.

**How Taught:** The facilitator utilizes PowerPoint to provide an overview of the learning objectives. Handouts are provided for future reference. An interactive “exercise” at the end of the program enhances the learning experience.

**A/V Needed:** Electrical power and a screen for the PowerPoint presentation. The facilitator supplies the laptop and projector.

**Target Audience:** Architects, Landscape Architects, Electrical Engineers, Owners and other design professionals in the commercial, industrial and educational markets. The ideal audience size is from 1 to 20. This program meets every experience level with sufficient time factored in for questions and answers.
